Course Outline for Adding Dimension to Quilts

This course will be held on Wednesdays, April 14, April 21, April 28, May 5, May 12 at 6:00 p.m. for 2 ½ hours. It will be held at the Bridge Adult Service Centre, 16 Station St., Amherst.

Phyllis is a retired school teacher and administrator. She has quilted for many years and has taught quilting as well as many other crafts.

Course Outline:

This course is for those quilters who wish to move away from more traditional quilting designs and explore techniques that add some dimension to their quilts. We will be exploring some of the techniques offered by Colleen Wise in her book "Casting Shadows". This course will be looking at the use of colour and value to create shadows.

The project is a quilt design by Colleen Wise. The quilt is 50" x 40"- a good size wall hanging or throw for the back of your couch. The skill required is basic cutting and sewing. Choice of fabric colours for the quilt is essential and will be covered during the first class.

At registration you will be provided with a picture of the project and some suggestions for fabrics needed for the course.

Supplies:

A sewing machine in good working order, basic sewing supplies – ruler, rotary cutter, mat, scissors, thread. Fabric, batting and backing required to complete a small quilt
