## **2010 FALL SESSION**

### ***Course Outline for Basic Watercolour***

***Instructor- Diana Mclsaac***

***This course will be held on Friday from 1:30-3:30 in the Amherst Stadium, heated room. The first class will be held on October 29 with subsequent classes on November 5, 12, 19, 26.***

Diana has been painting for the past few years. She is a current member, Past President and Director on the Board of the Sackville Art Association. For the past number of years, her work has been displayed province-wide and in surrounding areas.

Art supplies:

Watercolour brushes-1" flat, #12 round, small rigger brush

Watercolour pigments-gamboge or transparent yellow, cobalt blue, permanent or quinacridone rose

- 3 tubes of pigment, one each of red, yellow and blue are absolutely essential
- additional pigment: thalo blue, ultramarine blue, burnt sienna and alizarin crimson
- all pigments should be artist's quality

additional items needed: solid sheet of backing such as Plexiglas or plastic core (to attach paper to) roll of masking tape, paper towels, watercolour palette with mixing area, 1 or 2 containers (clean, empty yogurt or margarine tubs are fine), sketchbook, 2B drawing pencils, ruler and soft eraser.

5 sessions-

- 1 washes
- 2 charging in colour
- 3 layering and birch trees
- 4 values
- 5 perspective in composition
