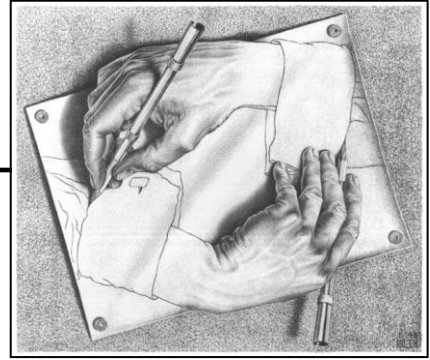


Drawing
