In the first class Patty will present a number of possible topics to the students and we will choose which to cover during these sessions. Possibilities include at least the following:

- Checking the gauge and making adjustments to ensure the correct gauge.
- Diagramming your pattern to check for errors and ensure it will fit
- Making pattern adjustments so that the garment fits.
- Knit a basic sock or a basic lace or cable sock.
- Cable knitting
- Basic Lace knitting
- Seaming techniques and practice to suit the weight of the yarn and the function of the seam
- Button hole types and practice, button application and other closures
