This will be a hands-on course, and you are encouraged to bring some of your own vacation/family pictures to work with.

Topics to be covered include:

- Downloading pictures from camera to computer
- Saving pictures on CD/DVD
- Editing pictures
- Adding pictures to PowerPoint/Movie Maker
- Adding captions to slides
- Adding title slides
- Adjusting slide/show times
- Inserting slide transitions/other effects
- Adding music to slide shows
- Including video files in slide shows
- Playing the slide shows
- Burning slide shows to DVD/CD
- Scanning old family photos/slides/negatives in to digital form
