

# Genealogy Research

**Description:** . It will be hands-on genealogy and we would like each person to come with the name of at least one ancestor they would like to research.

**Day 1** - We will explain family group sheets, pedigree charts and the sources of information available to complete these documents.(everyone should have a family group sheet completed at this session to use as a basis for the following research)

**Day 2** - Computer systems. We will put the family information provided on the first night into a computer genealogy system. Free genealogy programs can be downloaded from the internet to demonstrate how information is maintained and reports created.

**Day 3** - On-line sources of information. The sites will be identified and accessed for information.

**Day 4** - We will try to arrange a trip to Mount Allison University to expose people to the procedures for researching there and at other archives.
