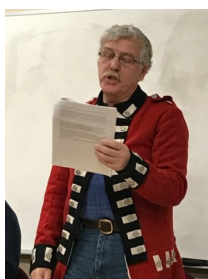

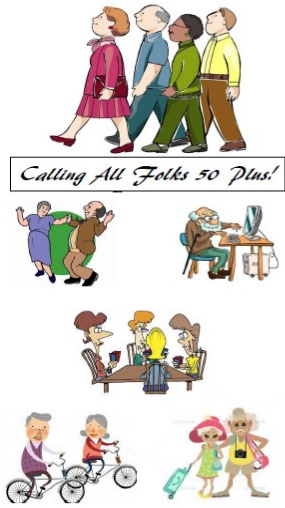
TSC TURNS TEN!
